November sub-committee meeting to allow City Manager Healy to notify the individual who is using the Arts & Culture Commission name. Councilperson S. Wood asked for an ordinance to be drafted for a five member commission, two council members and three citizen members. Manager Healy reported a "Moundsville Arts & Cultural Commission" name being used by an individual, however, they will be notified to remove that site from Facebook.
